- Date** Friday 27 September 2019
- Time** 12:00, but all attendees should be in the marquee by 11:45 at the latest.
- Location** Marquee at Hawes Creamery - this will be situated on the top car park.
- Dress** There is no requirement to wear black, but there is a special request to wear colourful socks and scarves please.

It is the family's express wish that the service will be open to everyone. There will be no ticketing, nor is it necessary to advise of your attendance.

Seating

There will only be a very small number of reserved seats, which will be as follows:

- to the front left of the aisle will be the seating for family and speakers
- to the front right of the aisle will be the seats for current serving civic dignitaries
- only limited seating will be available (to maximise the capacity) so we are encouraging people to bring festival style seating so that they can sit for the duration of the service and then quickly fold away - please ensure that you follow the approximate lines / row format, so that we can maximise the space available.
